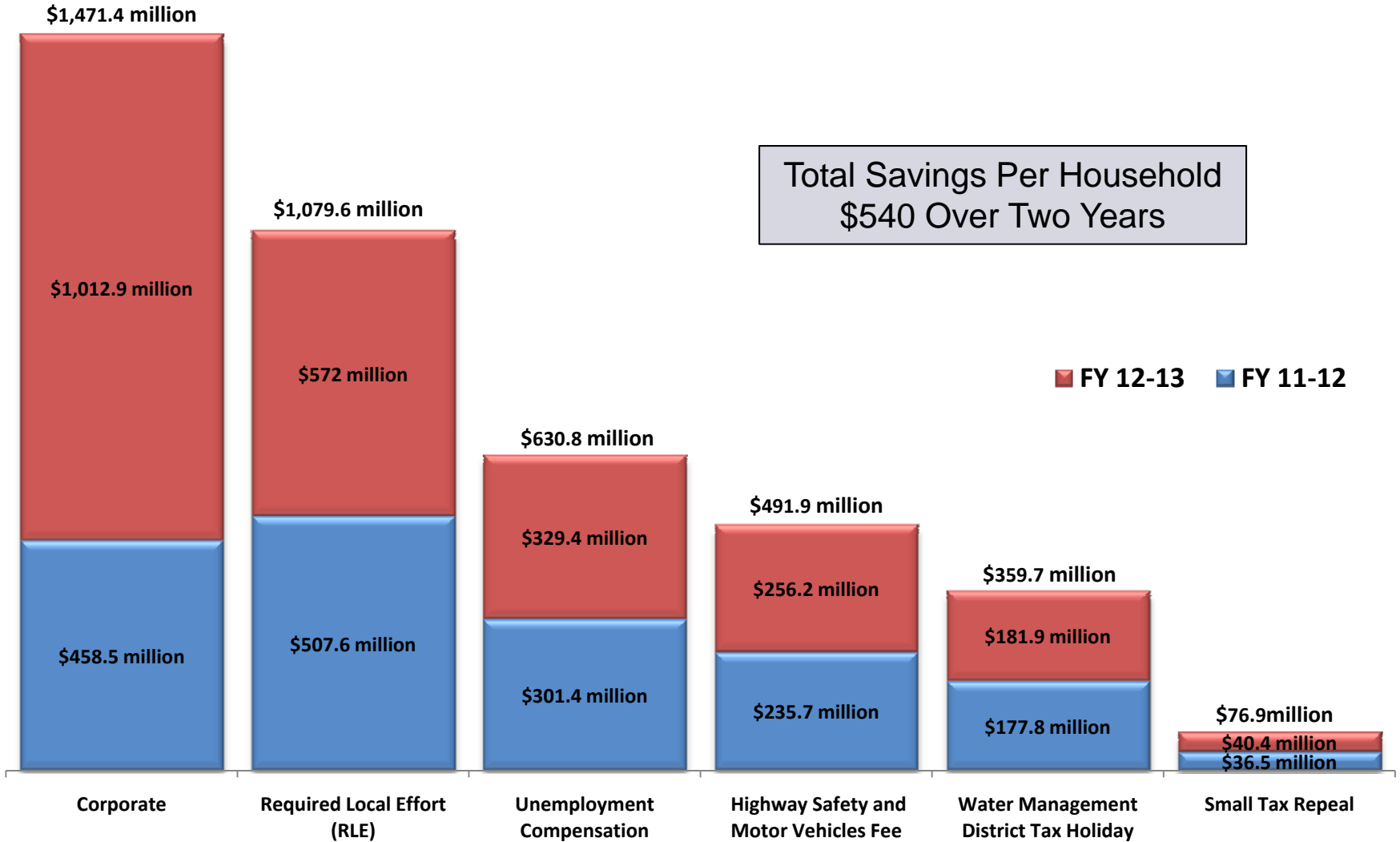

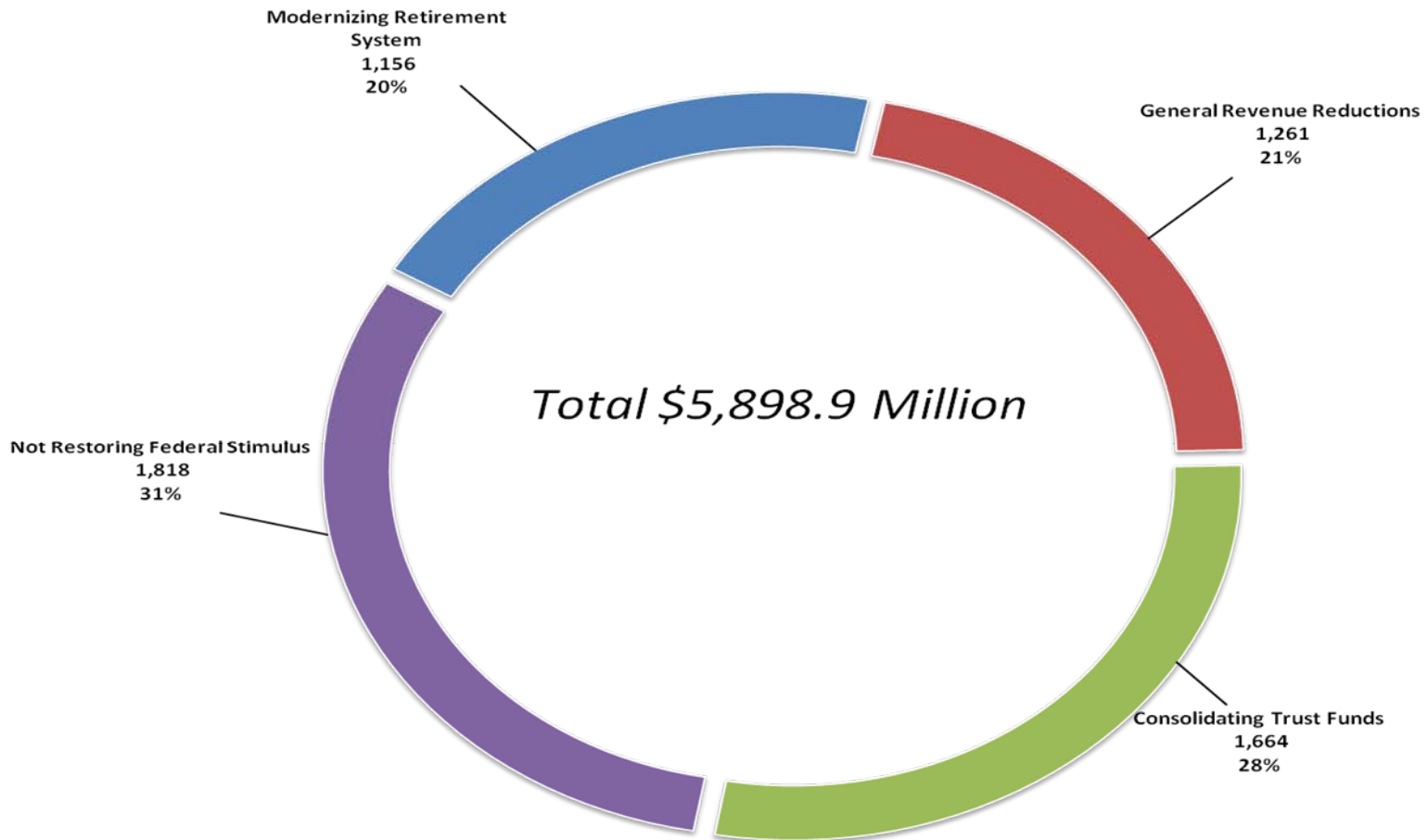

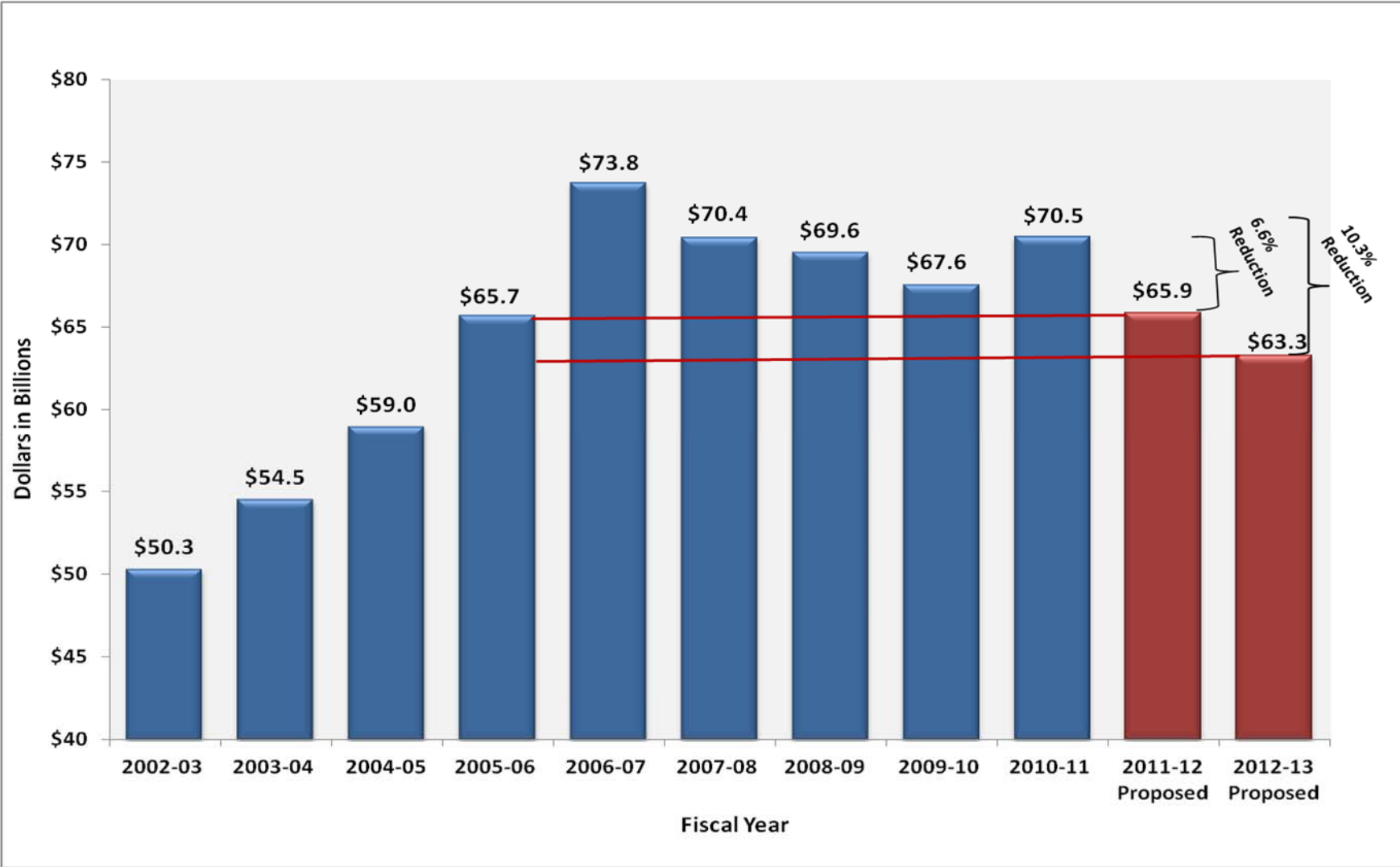
# Tax Relief - \$4.1 Billion Over Two Years



# Closing the Gap and Offering Tax Relief Fiscal Year 2011-12



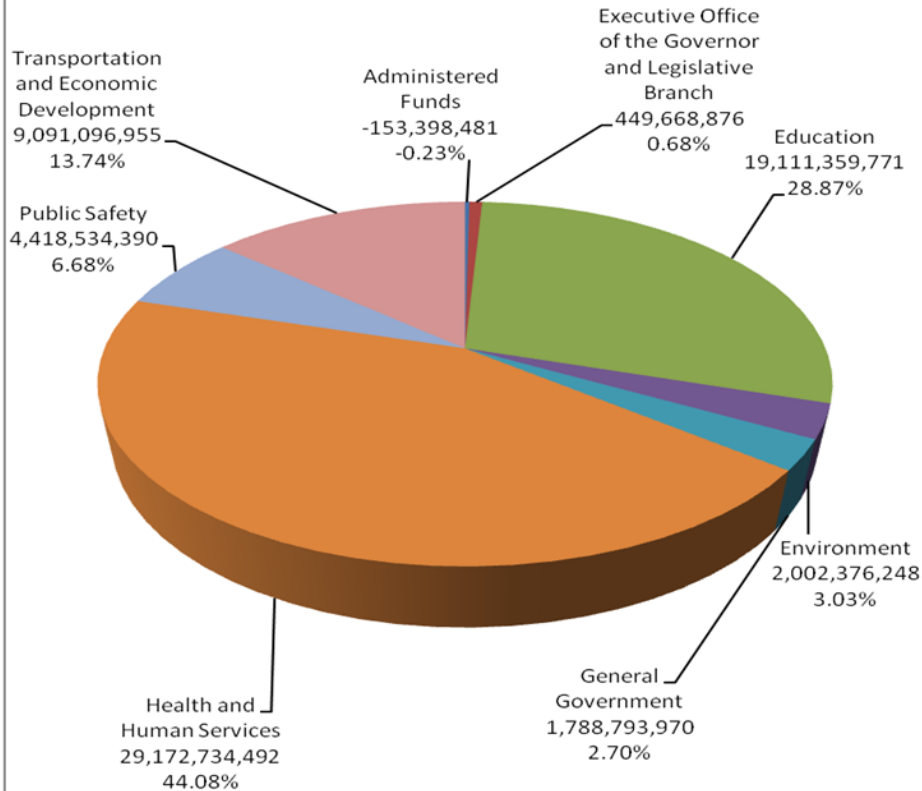

# Budget by Policy Area – FY 2011-12

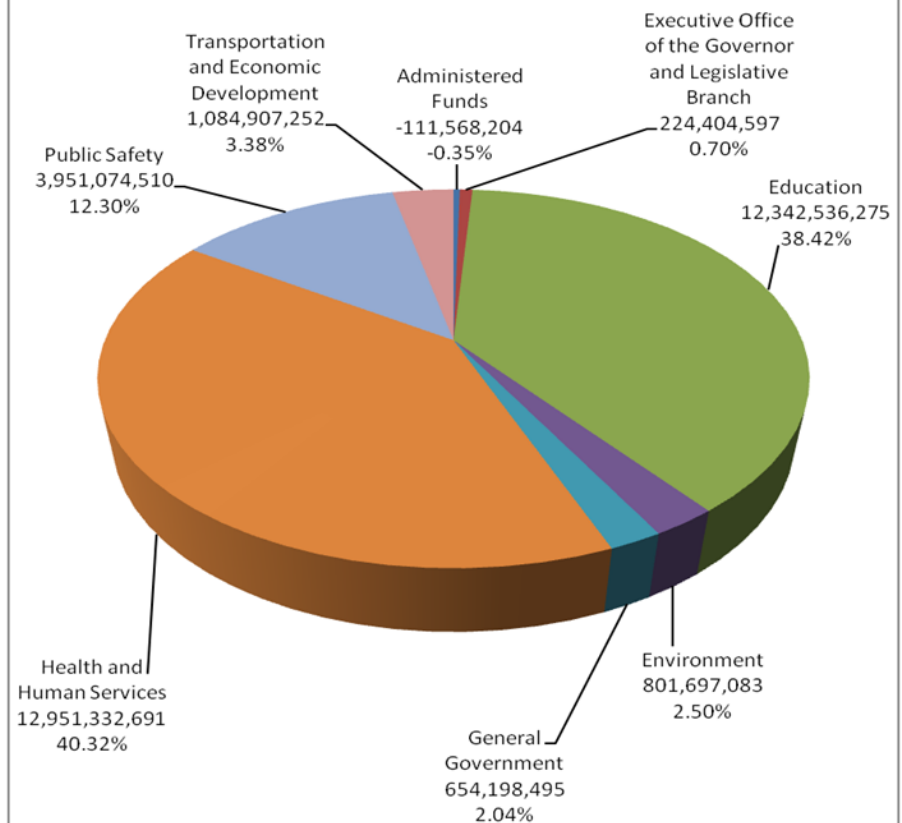
**Total Budget by Policy Area**
